

GLORIA ESTEFAN WILL OFFER IN MARBELLA THE FIRST CONCERT OF HER TOUR '90 MILES SPANISH TOUR 2008'

The show will be taking place on the 24th of August at the Puente Romano Hotel in Marbella

Marbella, 12 of June. The 'mother of the Latin pop' Gloria Estefan will play this summer on the 24th of August in Marbella, the big musical event will be taking place at the central court of the Tennis Club of the Puente Romano Hotel.

It will be the first show of the so-called '90 Miles Spanish Tour 2008' presented by the English musical promoter Spirit Productions, with the collaboration of the Delegation of Tourism of the Town Council of Marbella and the Puente Romano Hotel.

The Cuban singer Gloria Estefan will start in Marbella a tour of different shows all around Spain in August and September to present her last work, "90 Miles", live.

Marbella will be one of the few places where she will act. The singer, composer and Cuban actress declared recently that she was anxious for embracing again her Spanish fans that she defines as unconditional and that she has not seen since her last tour in our country in 1997.

Gloria Estefan (Havana, 1st September 1957) has sold up to the date about 90.000.000 of records all around the world. She is the singer that more records has sold in Latin America and one of the 20th that more records has sold in the story of world music.

She is known commonly as the "mother of the Latin pop " or also as the Latin Madonna because she is the singer that has made the Latin pop universally. Her last record launched in 2007, "90 Miles" is recorded in Spanish. The title means the distance between Miami and Cuba, 90 miles. Before the promotion of the album, the first single that went to the market was called No Llores. The record, published on the 18th of September 2007, sold 25.000 units in her first week and in Spain become golden disc, that was one of the reasons for which she traveled to our country to promote the album.

In this record, Estefan has worked with several actors like Andy Garcia or Generous Jiménez or with Latin artists as José Feliciano, La India, Carlos Santana, and in which she criticizes the communist government in Cuba led by Fidel Castro, has achieved a great world acceptance.

She will be coming with her Miami band of musicians, Gloria Estefan will make dance to Marbella with the sound of the Cuban rhythms with such emblematic songs as Mi tierra and Oye mi canto, Píntame de colores, one of the songs with more rhythm of the "90 Miles" album. Anything for you, Can't stay and Reach will turn over her records of the decades of the eighties and nineties, recorded in English.
